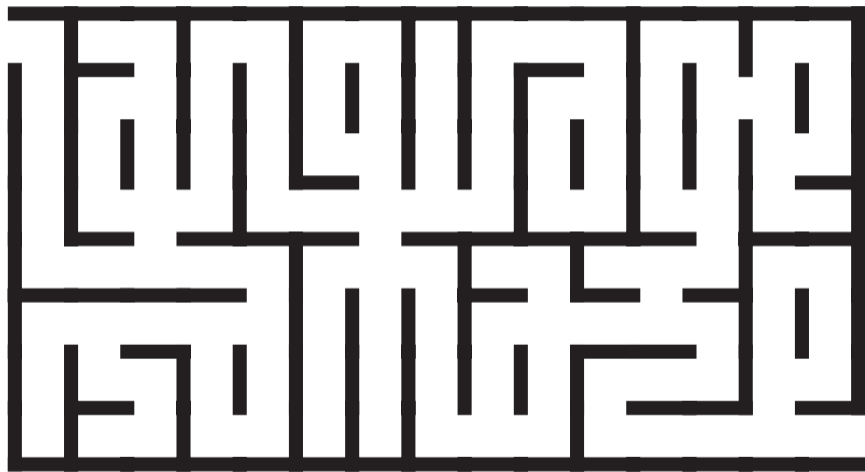


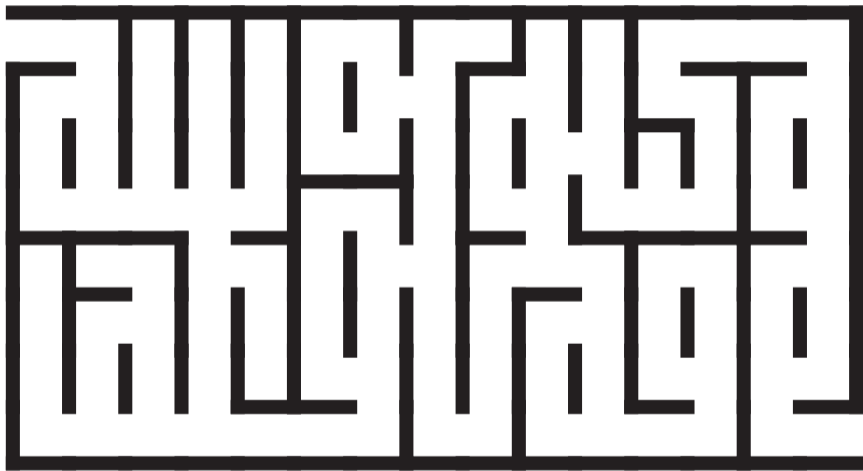


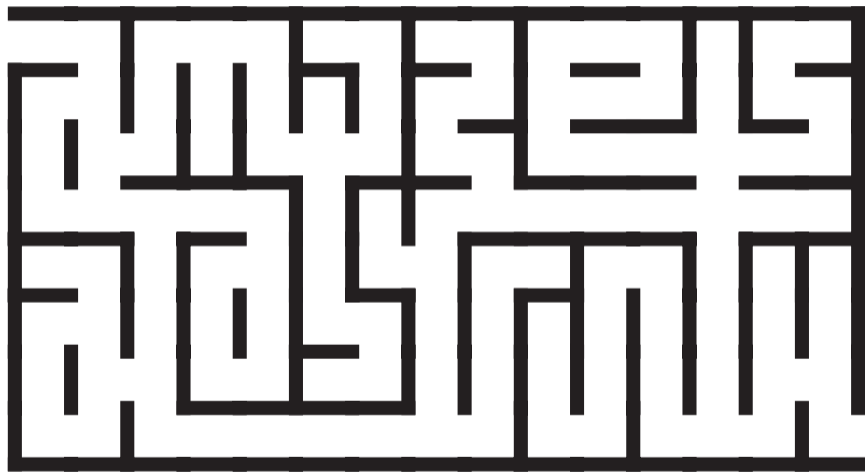
LUKE BRADFORD

FOUR PATHS

“Four Paths” is a visual poem which packs four sentences into rectangular mazes. In addition to remaining reasonably legible, the mazes obey various constraints: each is identical in size to the others, has an unobstructed path from the top left to the bottom right, has no passages other than those that form its letters, and has no inaccessible areas.
